Ken Leap: Silver Stain/Painting Workshop, Thursday 8am-noon Member: \$170 Non-member: \$185

This will be a four-hour silver-stain workshop, demonstrating and discussing the myriad uses of silver stain.

Attendees will paint hands-on and take away a set of fired and unfired samples of the various stains.
